

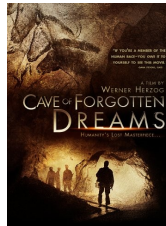
August 14th

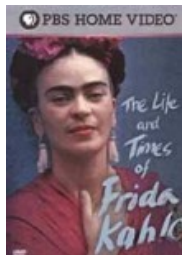
September 18th

October 16th

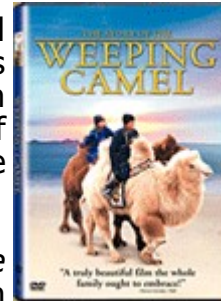

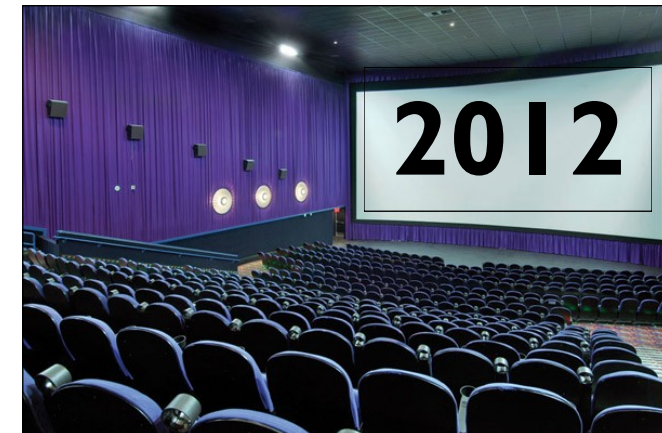

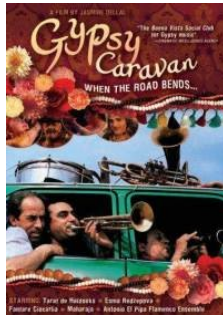

May 15th

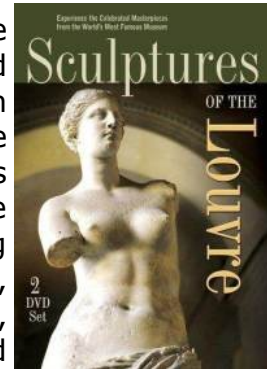
